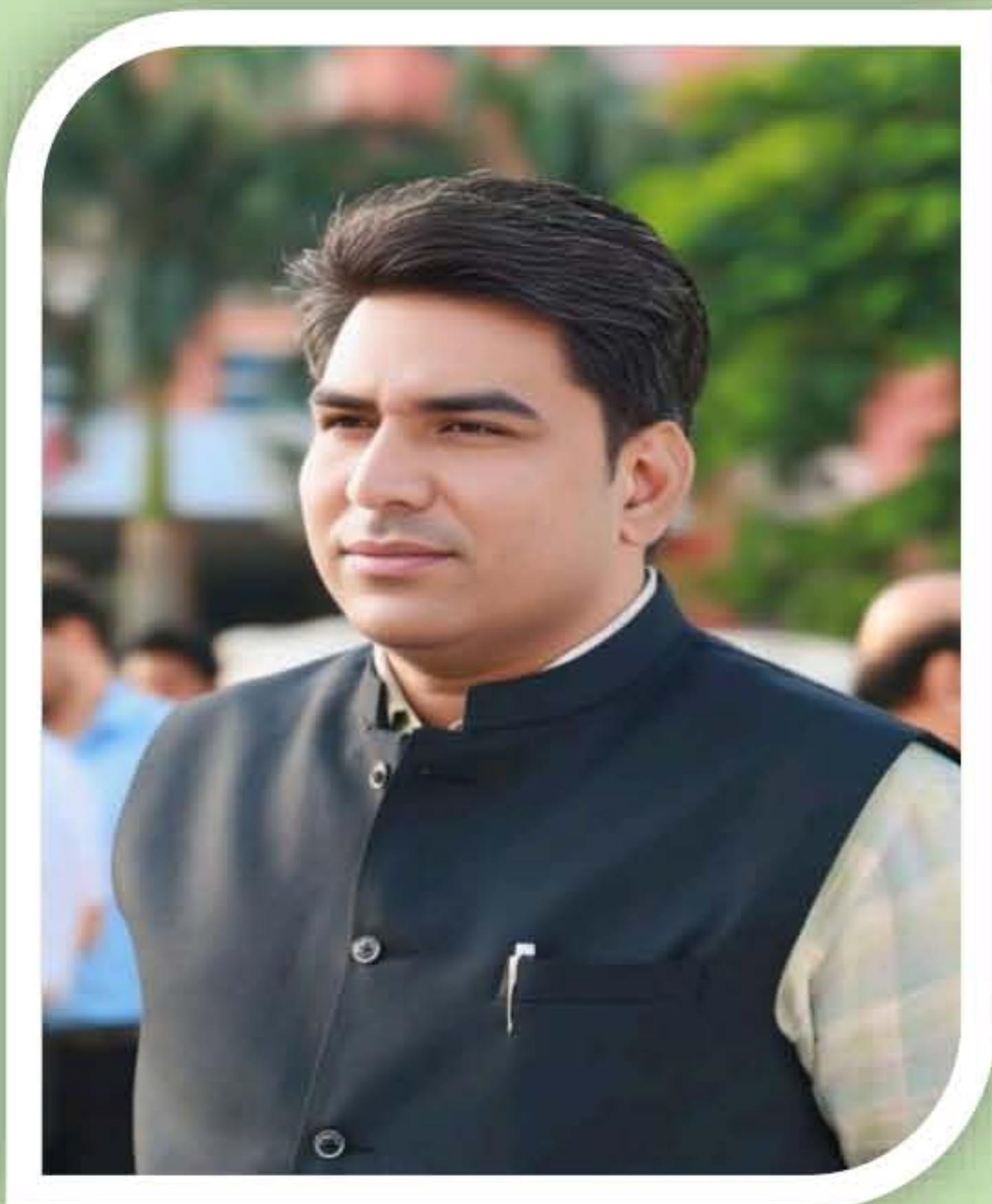

Admission Process

Eligibility and NEET UG Qualification

Candidates must have completed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as mandatory subjects and achieved a minimum percentage (e.g., 50% for general, 40% for reserved categories). Crucially, qualifying the NEET UG examination with the required percentile is mandatory for all applicants.



Online Registration

Eligible candidates must register online on the official MP AYUSH counselling portal by providing their NEET UG details and personal information.



Merit List Publication

After registration, the DME MP releases a state merit list based on NEET UG scores, which determines eligibility for further steps.



Choice Filling and Locking

Candidates then log in to the counselling portal to select their preferred BAMS colleges based on their rank and availability, a process they then lock in.



Seat Allotment

Based on NEET UG rank, preferences, category, and seat availability, the counselling authority publishes the seat allotment results online.



Reporting to Allotted College

Candidates who are allotted a seat must report to the respective college within the specified timeframe to complete admission formalities.



Further Rounds (Upgradation, Mop -Up, Stray Vacancy)

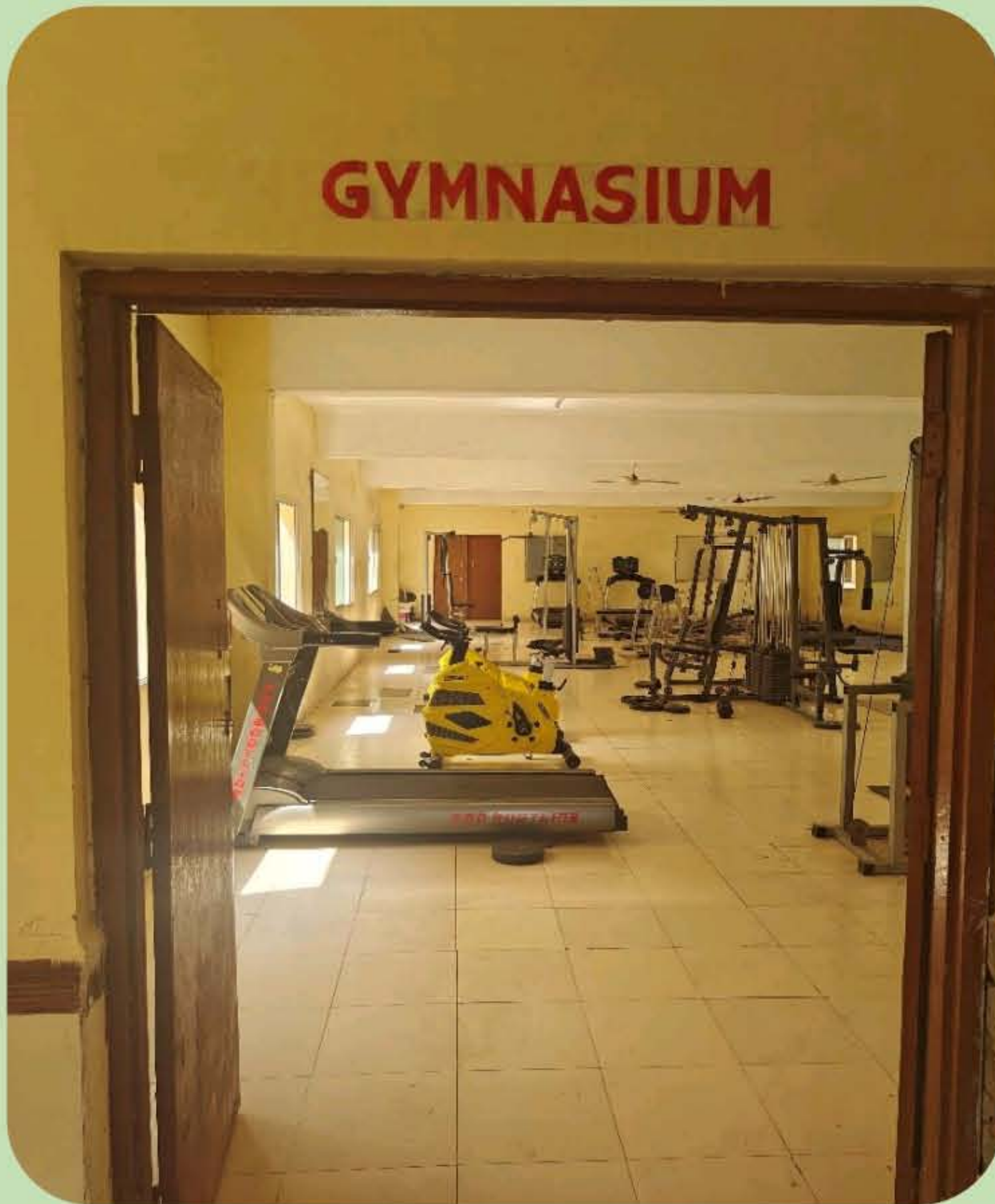

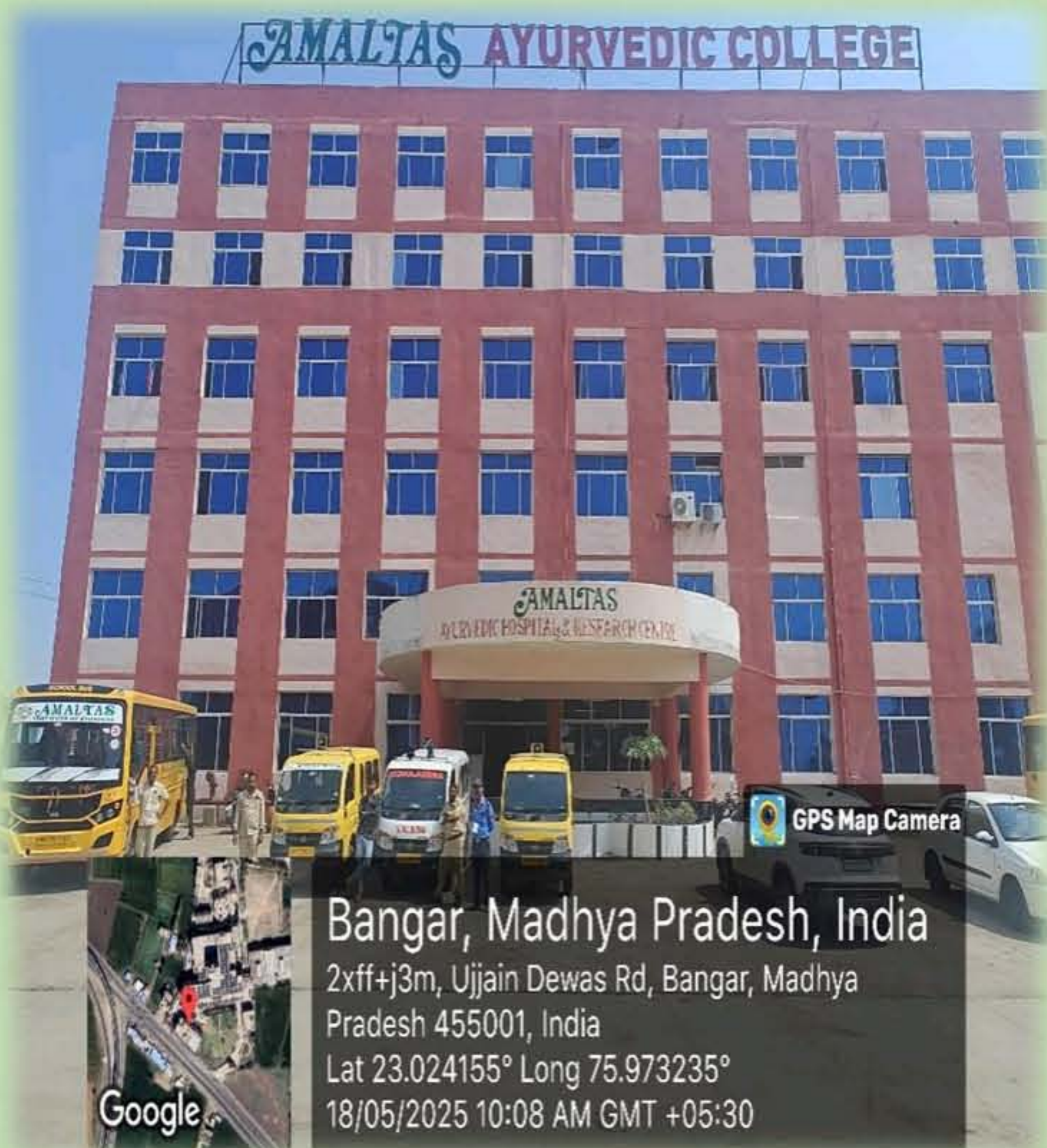

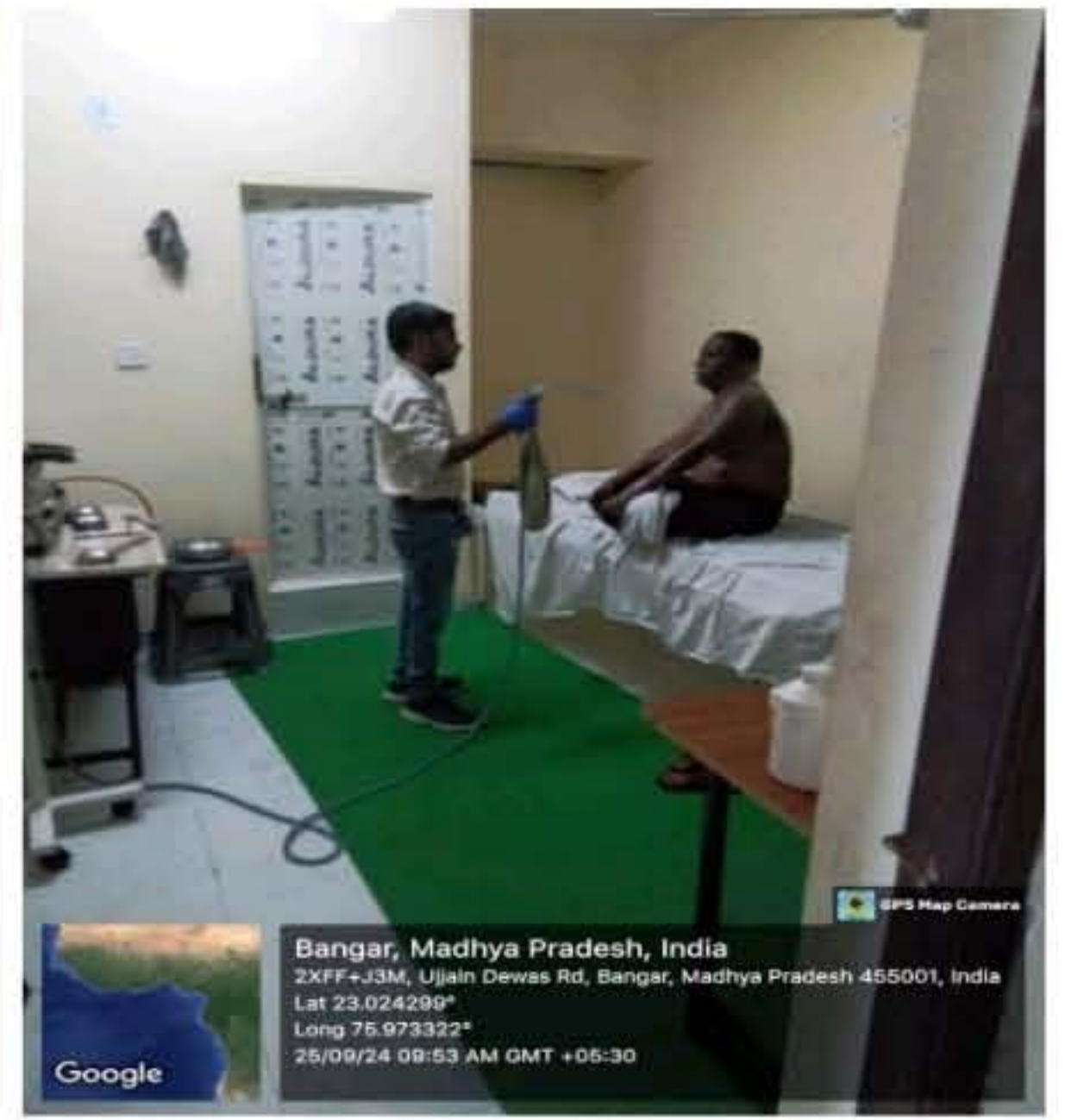
