Urticaria typically not associated with long term or serious complication. The condition may persisted itching and burning sensation lasts for few days and do not leave any long lasting skin changes. It was observed that only 5-7% cases of urticaria last for more than six weeks. Approximately 20% of the population experiences suffering of urticaria. The etiological prevalence of disease mentioned in Figure No.1.

The general sign and symptoms are raised skin patches with itching, the size of hives change rapidly or may sometimes disappears from one palace and

reappears at another places. The environmental factors such as; heat, cold and sunlight may also produces hives directly many times, others causes of disease described in Table No.1.

Sign and Symptoms

- Red coloured welts on skin.
- Itching.
- Painful swelling of the lips and eyelids.
- Burning sensation.

- 1. Acute urticaria: This occurs only for few days.
- 2. Chronic urticaria: This occurs at least for two months and some time for years.

Non immunologic


- Physical

3	Urticaria chiefly in finger and toes with itching and erythema. Urticaria appears and disappears suddenly and associated with tinnitus.	Antiphrinum
4	Urticaria with fever and burning pain.	Apis Mel
5	Urticaria with burning, restlessness and intense thirst	Arsenic Album
6	Urticaria covers whole body with a disposition of diarrhea.	Bovista
7	Urticaria at night when weather changes from warm to cool. Itching and burning after scratching.	Dulcamara
8	Urticaria characterized by its periodicity, its disappear at day and comes at night associated with emotional excitability and hallucination.	Chloralum Hydratum




Figure No.1: Prevalence and percentage of involved risk factor of chronic Urticaria
