राम मीणा देवास। विश्वभर में हर वर्ष 1 से 7 अगस्त तक 'विश्व स्तनपान सप्ताह' मनाया जाता है. जिसका उद्देश्य स्तनपान को बढावा देना, संरक्षण करना और इसके महत्व के प्रति समाज को जागरूक करना है। इसी क्रम में अमलतास इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ नर्सिंग साइंसेज (अमलतास युनिवर्सिटी) स्तनपान जागरूकता कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। कार्यक्रम में मुख्य अतिथि के रूप में चीफ ब्लॉक मेडिकल ऑफिसर डॉ. माया कल्याणी उपस्थित रहीं। डॉ. माया कल्याणी ने विद्यार्थियों को संबोधित करते हुए कहा कि नवजात शिश को जन्म के बाद पहले छह माह तक केवल माँ का दूध ही देना चाहिए। उन्होंने शिश को स्तनपान कराते समय सही ढंग से गोद में लेने की विधि, स्तनपान के शारीरिक व मानसिक लाभ, और छह माह के बाद पुरक आहार के सही तरीकों की जानकारी दी। उन्होंने कहा कि माँ का दूध न केवल शिश् के लिए सर्वोत्तम पोषण है, बल्कि यह बच्चे और माँ दोनों के स्वास्थ्य के लिए मजबूत आधार भी प्रदान करता है। कार्यक्रम की अध्यक्षता अमलतास यूनिवर्सिटी के कुलगुरु डॉ. शरदचंद्र वानखेड़े ने की। इस अवसर पर रजिस्ट्रार श्री संजय रामबोले, नर्सिंग प्रिंसिपल डॉ. संगीता तिवारी, जनरल





मैनेजर डॉ. मनीष शर्मा, डायरेक्टर डॉ. स्नेहा यूथम, विश्वविद्यालय के विभिन्न महाविद्यालयों के पाचार्य, शिक्षक एवं छात्र-छात्राएँ तथा अन्य गणमान्य अतिथि उपस्थित रहे। अमलतास स्पेशलिटी सपर हॉस्पिटल के चेयरमैन श्री मयंक राज सिंह भदौरिया ने कहा कि इस सप्ताह के माध्यम से हम समाज में एक ऐसी सोच विकसित करना चाहते हैं, जहाँ स्तनपान को एक सामान्य, स्वाभाविक और सम्मानित प्रकिया के रूप में स्वीकार किया जाए। उन्होंने कहा कि आधुनिक समय में जागरूकता और सही

जानकारी के अभाव में कई माताएँ शिशु को उचित पोषण नहीं दे पातीं, जिससे बच्चे के स्वास्थ्य पर नकारात्मक असर पड़ता है। ऐसे में स्वास्थ्य पेशेवरों, शिक्षण संस्थानों और समाज के संयुक्त प्रयासों से ही इस दिशा में बदलाव लाया जा सकता है। कार्यक्रम के अंत में निर्संग कॉलेज के विद्यार्थियों ने पोस्टर और स्लोगन के माध्यम से स्तनपान के महत्व पर संदेश दिए। मंच संचालन वरिष्ठ व्याख्याता द्वारा किया गया एवं आभार निर्संग प्रिंसिपल डॉ. संगीता तिवारी ने
