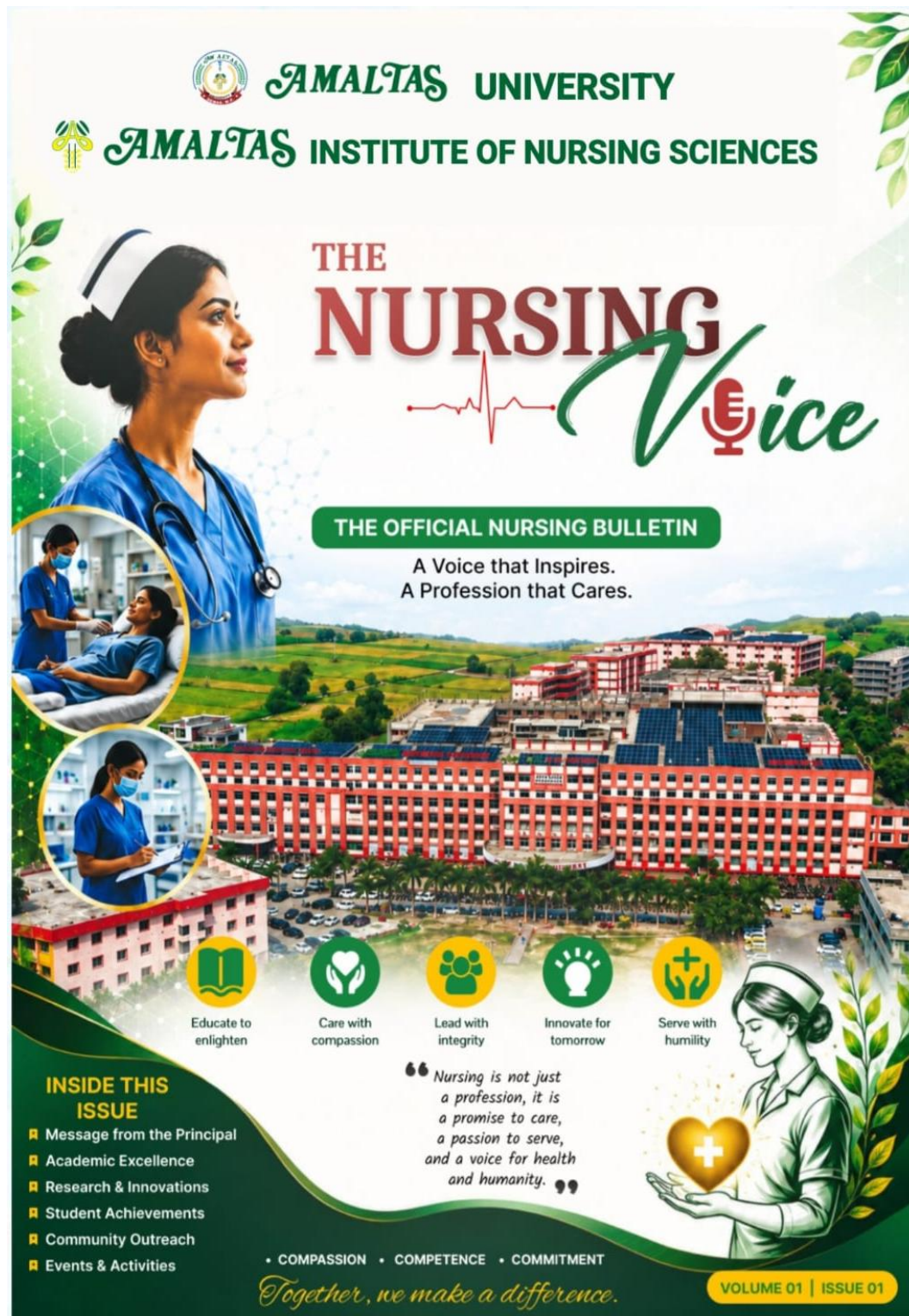
The journal will also provide students with an opportunity to document and present their academic and clinical learning experiences in a structured and meaningful manner.
